One of the most iconic flowers of Western Australia is the Chamelaucium or Waxflower.

Whether they be flowering, used for screens, feature plants or cut flowers... their uses are endless!

Late Winter & Spring is the time for waxes to perform, flower and show everybody just how beautiful and different they all are.

With just a light prune and dose of fertiliser after flowering, anyone can grow them successfully.

Chamelaucium are very hardy and provided the soil is well drained and plants are positioned in full sun, once established should require minimal maintenance and watering.

provides a welcome burst of colour with buds bursting open in late July.

has medium sized flowers in a pretty mid pink. Flowers from mid winter.
