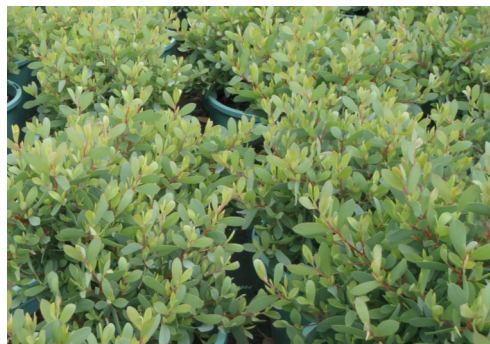

HELICHRYSUM HI HO SILVER
Medium shrub with velvety silver foliage. Fast and easy to grow. Responds well to shaping for low hedges, along retaining walls or curved paths. Drought tolerant once established.
H 1.5m W 1m



LEPTOSPERMUM FORESHORE (D)
Hardy shrub of green-grey foliage with rounded habit. It has bronze new growth. Useful for small spaces and low hedging. Tolerates coastal conditions. Drought tolerant once established.
H 50cm W 1m



OLEA MEDITERRANEAN MIDGET™ Non-fruiting variety of olive. Hardy water-wise plant with grey to olive-green leaves. Great for hedging. This Olea tolerates frost and coastal conditions. Sun or part shade.
H 1-1.5m W 1-1.5m

LEUCOPHYLLUM LAVENDER LIGHTS

Medium shrub with an abundance of lavender flowers after rain. Plant in a sunny position in well drained soil. Can be hedged.
H 1.5m W 1.5m



MAIREANNA SMOKEY™

Small shrub with unusual grey foliage. Great for contrast use in gardens beds for low plantings and borders. Plant in a sunny position in well drained soil. Low water requirements.
H 1m W 50cm



LOMANDRA SHARA™ (b)

Fine slightly tinged blue-grey foliage. In Spring, masses of tiny yellow flowers appear on stems above the foliage. Tolerates frost and a wide range of soil types.
H 40cm W 50cm



TEUCRIUM SILVER BOX

Compact form with upright habit. Mauve-blue flowers contrast against silver leaves from Autumn to late Spring. Responds well to clipping for hedging. Dry tolerant once established.
H 1m W 60cm



WESTRINGIA LITTLE WESTIE

Hardy dense shrub with grey-green leaves with silvery undersides. Dainty white to pale blue flowers appear sporadically all year with main flush from late Spring to early Autumn. Tolerant of dry and coastal conditions.
H 1m W 1m



OLEARIA GHOST TOWN

A native daisy with dainty white flowers during the warmer months. It has unique interesting textured grey foliage. Great low maintenance shrub. Drought tolerant once established.
H 70cm W 1m
