LOMANDRA

Lomandra are extremely tough Australian native grasses. Some watering is required to establish them as is the occasional water during long dry spells. They make excellent landscaping plants creating contrast in structural shapes. When choosing a Lomandra consider foliage colour and how big they will grow to suit the site.



BLUE RIDGETM has broad powdery blue-grey upright foliage which matures to a deep green. Mature plants will have a mixture of blue and green leaves. Best suited to free draining soil. Full sun to part shade. H 35cm W 30cm



FROSTY TOP (b) has lightly weeping, fine grey-green foliage with silver-frosted new growth. Tiny yellow flowers appear in the foliage in Spring and Summer. Full sun to part shade. H 15-25cm W 40-60cm **Frosty Top is similar to Lomandra Wingarra**



LIME WAVE (b) has long, bright green, fine foliage with a weeping habit. Spikes of cream yellow flowers appear in Spring and Summer. Highly ornamental, great for cascading over walls or tall pots. Full sun to part shade. H 70cm W 70cm



LIME TUFF (b) has fine lime green strappy leaves with small yellow flower spikes in Summer. Great for urban landscapes where there are height restrictions. Full sun to part shade. H 50-70cm W 50-70cm



LUCKY STRIPE (D is a taller grass with lime and green variegated leaves. Ideal for erosion control and landscape plantings. Tolerates frost. Suits sandy loam to heavy clay soils. Full sun to part shade H 80cm-1m W 90cm

LITTLE CON grows into a small rounded ball-shaped plant. Can be used in formal borders, rockeries, roundabouts and median strips. Full sun to part shade. H 30cm W 30cm LITTLE LIME is a smaller and more compact form of Lime Tuff. The foliage is finer and stays lush all year around. Useful for low borders and contrast in landscapes. Feed with slow release fertiliser. Full sun to part shade. H 40-50cm W 50cm

NYALLATM LM400 (b) is a semicompact fine leaved form of longifolia. Great for erosion control, windy sites and coastal conditions. Has small yellow flowers in Spring and does not produce seed. Full sun to part shade. H 80-90cm W 80-90cm



TANIKATM LM300 (b is an improved, compact form of longifolia. Soft to touch foliage. Ideal for slopes, roadsides and commercial plantings. Wind and drought tolerant, avoid wet feet. Full sun to part shade. H 50-60cm W 65cm





VERDAY LL364 (b is a tough semi-pendulous form of longifolia. This native grass thrives where most other plants struggle. Tolerates both sandy and clay soils, as well as being drought, frost and coastal tolerant. Full sun to part shade. H 60 W 1m Verday is similar to Lomandra Tanika
