Westringia Ozbreed Aussie Box™ 'WES08' (b)
A great native substitute for box hedges. Can be manicured or if left unpruned it forms a dense ball shape. Mauve flowers in Spring/Summer.

Westringia fruticosa Grey Box™ 'WES04' (b)
Is a great native alternative to the box hedge. It has a more compact habit than Aussie Box, with contrasting grey-green foliage and white flowers in spring.

Westringia fruticosa Low Horizon™ 'WES06' (b)
A very tough, dense groundcover with a flat, compact habit. White flowers in winter to spring. A low maintenance variety ideal for mass planting and borders.

Westringia fruticosa
A hardy dense, ever-green shrub with soft, velvety grey-green leaves. It produces white to light mauve flowers most of the year. Ideal for hedging, seaside and native gardens.

White Rambler



Westringia hybrid Blue Gem™ 'WES03' (b)
Masses of vivid blue/purple flowers appear predominately in Spring. It's dense bushy growth makes it a great native hedging alternative.



Smok-



Westringia fruticosa Mundi™ 'WES05' (b)
A tough evergreen groundcover with dense foliage that layers over to cover slopes, embankments and large areas. It has white flowers throughout Spring and Summer.

Westringia fruticosa Smokie
Smokey-grey and white variegated foliage with masses of white flowers appearing through Winter and Spring. A great contrast shrub well suited to coastal areas, low hedges and playgrounds.

Westringia White Rambler
A dense evergreen semi-prostrate shrub with a cascading habit. An abundance of white flowers are produced in spring and summer. Frost, salt and wind tolerant.



Jervis Gem



Westringia Jervis Gem
This hardy native is ideal for hedging with its compact habit and soft grey foliage. Lilac flowers cover the plant during Spring and Summer. It is drought tolerant and fast establishing.
